Instructions

This application is to be used for the removal of Above (AST) and Below (UST) ground storage tanks used for storing flammable or combustible liquids. Multiple tanks in a common pit are covered under a single permit.

If you are renewing an existing permit, enter the number in the space provided.

Provide the business name and 'Doing Business As' name if it is different. Often a business uses a corporate name that is different from the name on the location. If the inspection location is different from the billing office, enter it in the space provided. Parcel Identification Number (PIN) or Tax Map number may be used where there is no address for vacant land.

Provide the landowner information, where the tank will go and the laboratory information in the spaces provided.

Make sure to provide the name and contact information for the person filling out the application. The application with a check or money order payable to 'County of Loudoun' should be mailed to the address shown on the application. We are not equipped to accept cash or credit/debit cards at this time.

Once the permit is processed an inspection will be scheduled. It is important that you provide the proposed removal date. Common items we look for are:

- Fire extinguishers are present. No Smoking signs posted.
- Spoil piles are on plastic and protected to prevent runoff.
- Soil samples are collected from spoil pile and from under each tank. Multiple samples may be required based on size of tank(s).
- Obvious signs of leakage.

Excavations may be backfilled with the express understanding that they may have to be reopened at the owner's expense for remediation based on the laboratory report.

In-place closures are only considered in cases where excavation will cause structural damage. Supporting documentation must be provided with the application.

This list covers the most common items related to these operations. Not all of these items apply to every location, and some have additional specific requirements. If you have questions related to a specific use or operation, please contact the Fire Marshal's Office for additional assistance.

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
